Position Overview

A Pipeline Integrity instructor shall have the skills and knowledge to plan, organize, and present classroom, laboratory, demonstration, and/or on-the-job instruction, training, and/or education programs in accordance with course outlines approved by the Quality Manager.

- Shall possess strong skills in basic Microsoft Office platform tools such as Word, Excel, Power Point, Outlook, Forms.
- Shall possess strong interpersonal skills with the ability to explain and simplify highly technical subjects and requirements to a wide variety of classroom students with different skill sets and experience levels.
- Should possess strong skills or exhibit the ability to adapt and learn enhanced skills in the following Microsoft Office platform tools: Teams, SharePoint, Forms, and other apps in the suite.
- Shall be capable of writing Inspection Test Plans (ITP's), and Work Procedures (WP's) within their disciplines and realms of expertise and experience.
- Shall be capable of developing written training material and delivering training classes consisting of theoretical and practical components that comply with the requirements defined by the IAG NDE Quality Manager.
