

Title: Senior Advanced Pipeline Integrity Technician

Department: Integrity Services

Location: Remote

Position Overview

These technicians/inspectors shall have the skills and knowledge to set up and calibrate equipment, to conduct tests, and to interpret, evaluate, and document results in accordance with procedures approved by the Quality Manager. Technicians holding this position shall be thoroughly familiar with the scope and limitations of the system and software implemented across our Integrity Services Division.

Requirements:

- Shall hold at least 1 x Specialized Operator / Equipment Certification and 1 or more years of experience in those disciplines.
- Shall hold at least 2 x Level II NDE Discipline Certifications and at least 8 to 15 years of inspection experience.
- Shall possess strong problem solving and communication skills along with high capabilities to utilize computers and cloud-based data management and reporting systems.
- Shall possess strong skills in basic Microsoft Office platform tools such as Word, Excel, Power Point, Outlook.
- Should possess strong skills or exhibit the ability to adapt and learn enhanced skills in the following Microsoft Office platform tools: Teams, SharePoint, Forms, and other apps in the suite.
- Should be capable of writing Inspection Test Plans (ITP's), and Work Procedures (WP's) within their disciplines and realms of expertise and experience.
- Should be capable of developing written training material and delivering training classes consisting of theoretical and practical components that comply with the requirements defined by the IAG NDE Quality Manager.
- Shall be capable of being qualified to and acting in the capacity of a Quality Auditor within the IAG Quality Management System to perform field audits on the various activities that impact the Integrity Services Division.
- Shall be capable of operating in a Project Management capacity for projects that involve additional crews made up of peers and additional Pipeline Integrity Technicians and Pipeline Trainees.
- Shall be capable of directing the work of trainees and Pipeline Integrity Technicians - Level I and Level II personnel.
- Shall be capable of performing QA/QC review functions on their own deliverables material that meets or exceeds the defined Quality Reporting process targets for the Integrity Services Division reporting systems to ensure the quality standard is being met and maintained.
- Shall be able to organize and report test results across the different inspection tools, ITP's and services offered within the Integrity Services Division.
